INDEPENDENT HONORARY ASSURANCE REPORT

Pursuant to the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permit issued by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("SWD"), we have been requested to report on the attached income and expenditure account of the Charity's regional flag day fund-raising activity in New Territories Region held on 13th October, 2018 ("the Event").

Responsibilities of the Charity

The directors of the Charity are responsible for preparing the attached income and expenditure account in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2, setting out the gross subscriptions raised from the Event and the expenses incurred in connection with the Event, in order to comply with the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permit issued by the SWD. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the income and expenditure account so that it reflects the subscriptions raised and expenses incurred in connection with the Event and is free from material misstatement.

Our Independence and Quality Control

We have complied with the independence and other ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA"), which is founded on fundamental principles of integrity, objectivity, professional competence and due care, confidentiality and professional behavior.

We apply Hong Kong Standard on Quality Control 1 and accordingly maintain a comprehensive system of quality control including documented policies and procedures regarding compliance with ethical requirements, professional standards and applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

Our Responsibilities

Our responsibility is to form a conclusion on the attached income and expenditure account, based on our engagement, and to report our conclusion to you.

We conducted our engagement in accordance with Hong Kong Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000 (Revised) "Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information" and with reference to Practice Note 850 (Revised) "Reporting on Flag Days and General Charitable Fund-raising Activities Covered by Public Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department" issued by the HKICPA. We have planned and performed our work to obtain limited assurance for giving our conclusion below.

The work undertaken in connection with this engagement is less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Our Responsibilities

Our engagement included carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquiries primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary. The procedures performed in a limited assurance engagement vary in nature and timing form, and are less in extent than for, a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

Inherent Limitations

Due to the nature of cash receipts and expenses relating to the Event, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the income and expenditure account and the books and records of the Charity includes all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the income and expenditure account. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the income and expenditure account prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Charity's books and records.


Conclusion

NOTES TO INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT

Flag Day held on 13th October, 2018

1. GENERAL

South Kwai Chung Social Service (the "Charity") is incorporated in Hong Kong as a company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital. The principal activities of the Charity are the provision of charitable services including adult education, medical and social services to the public in Kwai Tsing District.

The "Flag Day" (the "Event") is an annual fund raising event organised by the Charity. The purpose of the Event is to raise funds to (1) program expenses for community health promotion activities and social services) (2) centre operation expenses (water, electricity, rent etc) (3) renovation cost and purchases of equipment.

The Event was held on 13th October, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. within the area of the New Territories region only.

2. PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation

The income and expenditure account has been prepared using the historical cost basis of accounting.

Income recognition

Street collections and other donation are recognised on receipt basis.

3. SURPLUS OF THE EVENT

The surplus were transferred to the Community Health Project's Fund, which is administrated and controlled by the Charity.

4. INCOME TAX

As the Charity is registered as a charitable organization under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance, the surplus of the Event is exempted from Hong Kong Profits Tax.
